On the 19th of July England will move to the final stages of easing Covid restrictions.

Due to the nature of our industry, providing close contact services, we feel it is extremely important that we continue to reduce risk as much as possible. We still have a great responsibility to protect our staff, some of whom have not yet received their double vaccination, as well as all of our clients, who's personal circumstances may still mean that they are considered to be in a vulnerable position.

Also, as a profession which has been closed down for many months over the last year and a bit, it is vital that we continue to try and eliminate any possible factors which could lead to further periods of closure or our staff members having to self isolate.

The latest government guidance still recommends that people wear a face covering when coming into contact with those you don't normally meet. Therefore, at this stage, we would greatly appreciate it if you would continue to wear a mask when coming into close contact with any members of our team. Our team members have chosen to continue wearing masks when attending to you in close proximity. We kindly ask that when moving around the salon you keep a respectful distance from others at all times.

We will also carry on paying careful attention to hand hygiene, along with maintaining the thorough sanitisation of all salon areas and equipment. All of our protective screening will be remaining in place.

If you have been in contact with someone who has coronavirus or you are displaying any symptoms, such as a cough, temperature or shortness of breath, please DO NOT attend the salon.

We will continue to monitor the situation cautiously and make updates where necessary.
